Scholarship Nomination Criteria and Conditions

ATTENTION: This form is intended for completion by a nominator who falls into one of the following categories: coach, teacher, mentor, tutor, or community leader. Before proceeding, please review the eligibility criteria and requirements for the candidate.

FLY Scholarship: Merit-Based Opportunity for All Students

The FLY scholarship application is available to all students. Please note that it is solely based on merit and not income. Even if students are not eligible for an emergency, direct support, or educational assistance, they are still welcome to apply for FLY's \$1000 scholarship.

Scholarships are awarded based on the following:

- **Most Punctual:** For students attending tutoring services.
- **Best Attendance:** For students attending tutoring services.
- **Academic Improvements:** For students attending tutoring services.
- **Student-Athlete:** Academic achievers who maintained or improved their grades while participating in sports and FLY activities.
- **Best FLY Student Mentor:** FLY student volunteers who exhibited exemplary leadership skills.

Terms and Conditions:

- The nominator is required to fully endorse and support the nomination of the student.
- The nominator has determined that the nominated students are on track to complete the 2022-2023 school year.
- The nominator has concluded that the nominee is highly likely to enroll in school for the 2023-2024 academic year. This could be in the form of advancing to the next grade level in high school or pursuing and potentially completing post-secondary education.
- The student applicants **MUST meet one of the following FLY participation criteria:**

Award Category 1: FLY Activity Participant

For students attending tutoring, coaching, or mentoring services for at least five (5) sessions.

Most Punctual

Best Attendance

Academic Improvement

Award Category 2: Student-Athlete

This refers to academic achievers who have taken part in at least three (3) FLY basketball camps or learning sessions while participating in sports and have either maintained or improved their grades.

Award Category 3: Best FLY Peer Student Tutor or Mentor

This pertains to FLY students who have demonstrated outstanding leadership abilities and have volunteered for a minimum of five (5) FLY activities.

Please note that to ensure the FLY Project objectives are met, the FLY team will distribute the \$1000 scholarship in two (2) installments.

- 1st \$500 cheque – between March and May 2023
- 2nd \$500 cheque – June 2023, on or after the FLY Recognition Day

Student Application Steps and Procedures:

1. Students must complete and submit the web form titled **FLY Student Registration and Consent (2023-01) | [TEC-0001](#)**.
2. Email the following documents to services@theexpertcollective.ca:
 - a. Valid Student ID
 - b. Valid Government-issued ID with a photo
 - c. Student's latest progress report, or unofficial transcript
3. When applying for FLY Scholarships:
 - a. To be eligible for nomination, a student applicant must be nominated by someone who is either their teacher, tutor/mentor, sports coach, organization, or community leader.
 - b. The nominator must complete the FLY Scholarship Nomination Form.
 - c. The nominator must email the completed FLY Scholarship Nomination Form to services@theexpertcollective.ca
4. Participation in FLY activities is a requirement for all student applicants, which includes activities such as tutoring or mentoring, basketball sports camps, learning sessions, and other FLY events.
5. Once the funding or scholarship application is approved, the student will need to work closely with the FLY personnel to coordinate the logistics of receiving the award.

Scholarships will be handed out at the FLY Recognition Day, on June 3rd, 2023.
