Regardless of your status, apply to be assessed based on other criteria.



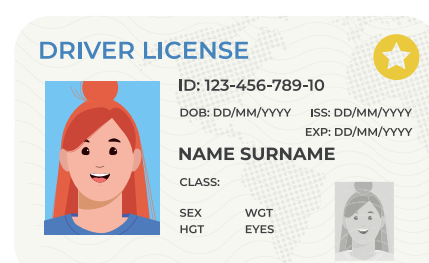
HOW TO RECEIVE EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE:

(1) REGISTER ONLINE:



Fill out the FLY Student Registration form. (TEC-0001)

(2) SUBMIT DOCUMENTS:



- Student ID
- Government Issued ID
- Student Transcript
- Lowest Income (2019-2023)
- Family Size



Do NOT submit documents with sensitive information
Ex. Social Insurance Number (SIN)

(3) CONFIRM ELIGIBILITY

Once we receive all the required forms and documents, our social worker will assess your eligibility. Whether you are eligible or otherwise, we will send email confirmation.



(4) ATTEND AN EVENT:

To pick up your item, attend one of our events!
